## Second 2019 Summer Outing

Tuesday 18th June to Bryncelyn, a National Gardens Scheme garden opening for the first time in 2019.

Bryncelyn is a 3 acre country garden and paddocks with deep beds of perennial planting with mature trees & shrubs chosen to attract birds.

It has flat lawns and gravelled areas around the house merge into sloping lawns, dropping down to a lake and stream, and all blending into the spectacular backdrop of the near hills, with views opening out across to Cefn Coca and the Berwyns. You can meet the resident donkeys and strut with the peacocks or find a seat and lose yourself in the tranquillity of this special place.

Garden is disabled friendly around the house, with flat lawn, gravelled areas, and easily accessed seats, but grassland does drop sharply to lower levels. Partial wheelchair access over gravel area then brick path and grass.

Car Share, leaving Trefonen from the Public Car Park next to the playing field at 2 p.m. on Tuesday 18th June, or make your own way there, arriving around 2:30 p.m.
